





#### 4. Categories:

Innovation procurement strategy award

Facing societal challenges award

Procurement leadership award to reward holistic and dedicated strategy and/or action plan that trigger sustainable innovation procurement practices

to reward those innovative procurement practises aimed to face covid-19 pandemic and/or its consequences during the recovery phase

To reward one or more outstanding individuals and/or legal entities who create strong role models and empower others to succeed and trigger new innovation procurement practices



In each category: 1 winner (75 000€) + 1 runner up (25 000 €)



#### 5. Eligibility criteria 1/2



#### Innovation procurement strategy and the Facing societal challenges category –

- eligible applicants are any public and/or private procurers, as well as individuals/natural persons
- the awarded procurement practice must relate to completed or ongoing initiatives started **after 1 January 2018**. (*In case of ongoing initiatives, only work completed by the submission deadline will be considered for the prize*.)

For the **Procurement leadership category**, eligible applicants are any public and/or private procurers, individuals/natural persons and/or legal entities supporting procurement practice



The awarded procurement **practice** must have taken place in a Member State or in an Associated Country to HE.



#### 5. Eligibility criteria 2/2



Participants can only **apply to <u>one</u> of the three categories** with the same application and set of activities.

Winners of former European Innovation Procurement Awards editions, as well as runnersup of the edition organised one year prior to the current edition are not eligible.

Applicants that have already received an EU or Euratom prize cannot receive a second prize for the same activities.



#### 6. Award criteria

Criterion	Purpose
Transformation	stimulating the conversion of procurement practices towards innovation procurement with the aim to ensure a sustainable and inclusive growth
Uptake	the innovative procurement practise is replicable and scalable, and, therefore, contributes to providing, more efficient and effective solutions
Collaboration	demonstrated co-operation linked to the innovation procurement practice, established synergies, promotion of best practices
Societal impact	practices with a demonstrated positive quantitative and qualitative impact on society, with special emphasis to achieving the green deal and digital transformation priorities








#### Step 3: Prize ceremony & dissemination

- Your proposal is like a project: take care of time, costs and performances
- Pay attention to ethical aspects of your proposal, they are important
