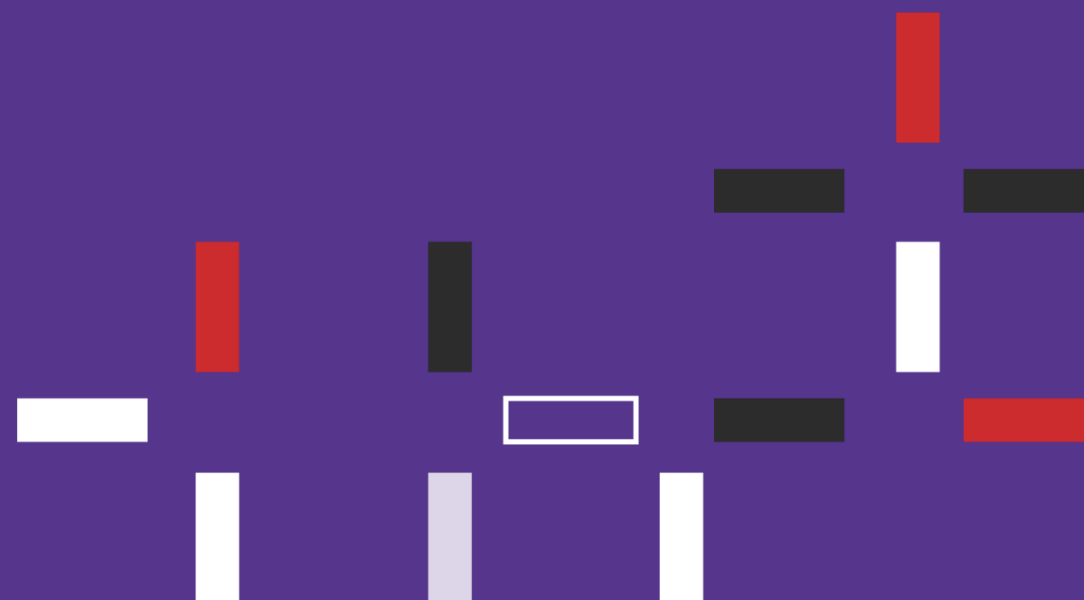

Budget

€ 10 billion

Unique

combines research & accelerator for SMEs, startups, scaleups

Largest deep-tech innovator in Europe

Over €3 billion

Enhances the European Innovation Ecosystems

Partnerships with ERC,EIT regions...

Annual Work Programmes (separate from Horizon Europe main WP)

- First WP (2021) adopted 18 March 2021, €1.5 billion
- Second WP (2022) adopted 7 February 2022, €1.7 billion
- Third Work Programme (2023) adopted 7 December 2022, € 1.7 billion



Pathfinder

- For **consortia**
- **TRL 1-4** (Early stage research on breakthrough technologies)
- Grants up to € 3 to 4 million

- For **consortia & single** researchers /companies
- **TRL 3-6** (Proof of concept to validation)
- Grants up to € **2.5 million**

Transition

- For **individual companies**
- TRL 6-9 (Development & scale up)
- **Blended** finance
 - grants up to € 2.5 million
 - equity up to €15 million

Accelerator



Pathfinder

- selection of first set of “**portfolios**” to be pro-actively managed by EIC Programme Managers

Transition

- move to **continuous call** with regular cut-offs (~ every 6 months)

Accelerator

- **High level of demand** (~1000 full applications per each cut-off)
- Major **improvements in Time to Grant** towards 5 months KPI - following initial delays in 2021
- Restart of operations of the **EIC Fund** (large number of investment decisions already taken under the new structure, overcoming the backlog)

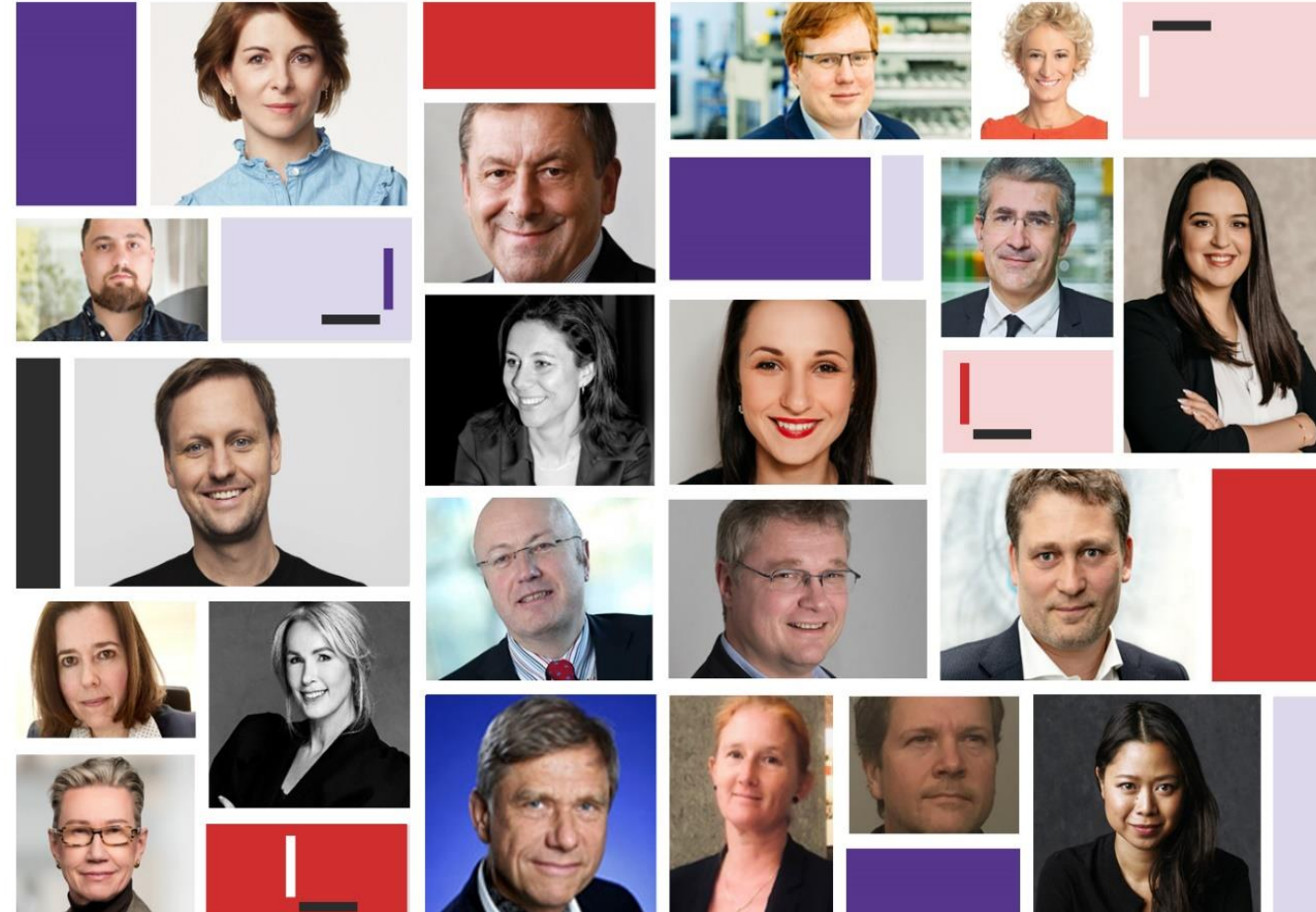

Strategic role of the EIC Board

- Publication of **strategic goals and KPIs** (incorporated in Work Programme)
- **Published** statements on EIC Fund, 2022 Work Programme, inputs to European Parliament
- Internal **advice on 2023 Work Programme**, including on challenges and new actions
- **Presence at major events**, and organisation of **joint workshop with ERC** (on Energy Storage)

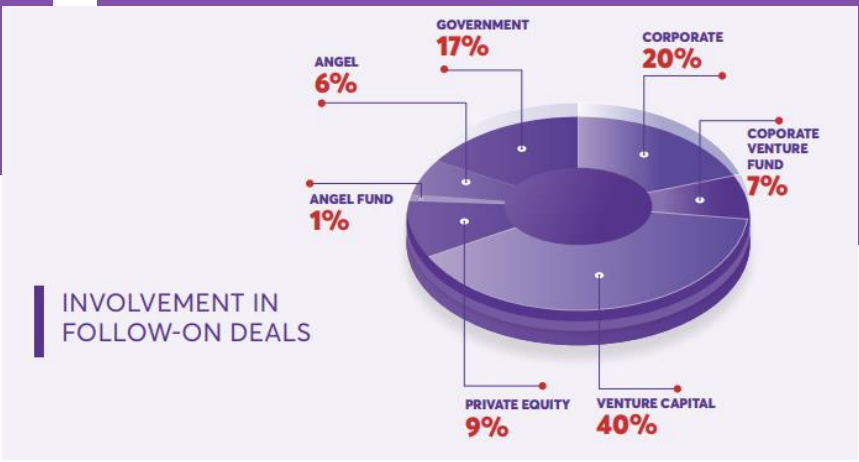
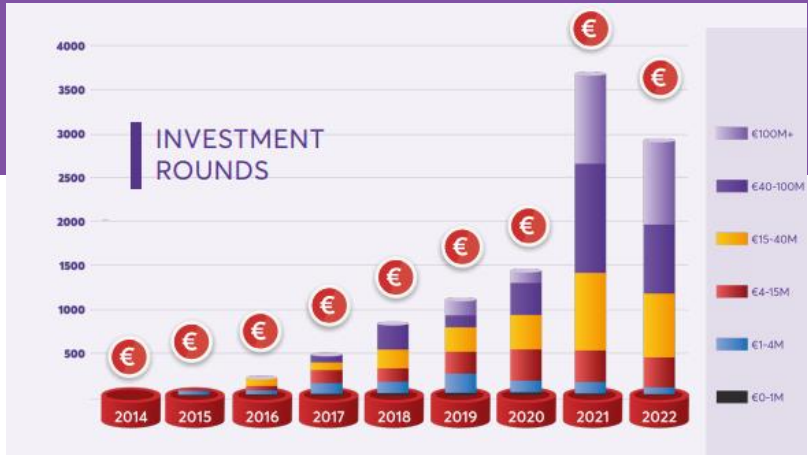
Impact Report

Target audience: investors, policy makers

- **Covers 2014-21: 1600 start-ups/ SMEs** (not 3500 SME Phase 1) & **500 Pathfinder/ FET**
- **Pathfinder:** Over 1300 innovations identified
- **Portfolio analysis** on 7 areas

Crowding in investment: €10bn of follow-on funding

with trend towards larger deal sizes. Portfolio valuation ~ €40bn. Corporates and Corporate VC involved in 27% of deals (by number)



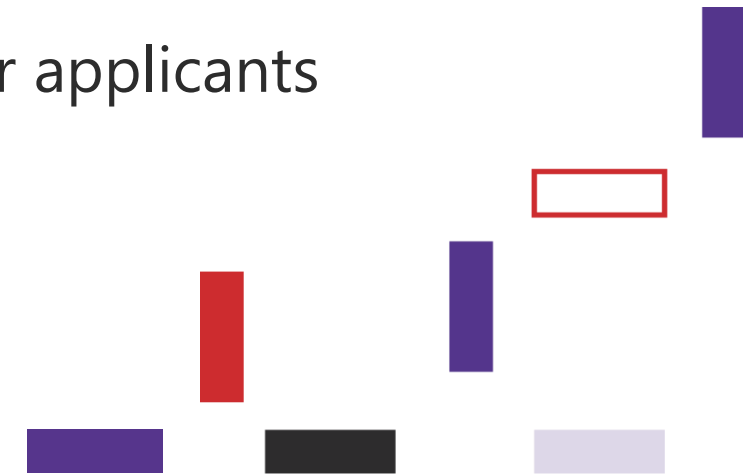


New European Innovation Agenda actions - EIC WP23

- **Next Generation Innovation Talents**
- Enhanced support to **women innovators**
(opening the Fast Track to the Accelerator to Women Tech.EU and the EIC Women Leadership Programme to EIT women-led deep-tech startups)
- Support to test EIC innovations for **public and private procurers**
- **Innospace Platform**

Ongoing restructuring of the EIC Fund

- **Indirect management** - the Commission plans to entrust tasks related to the implementation and management of the investment component of the EIC Accelerator to an implementing partner
- **No change** for applicants

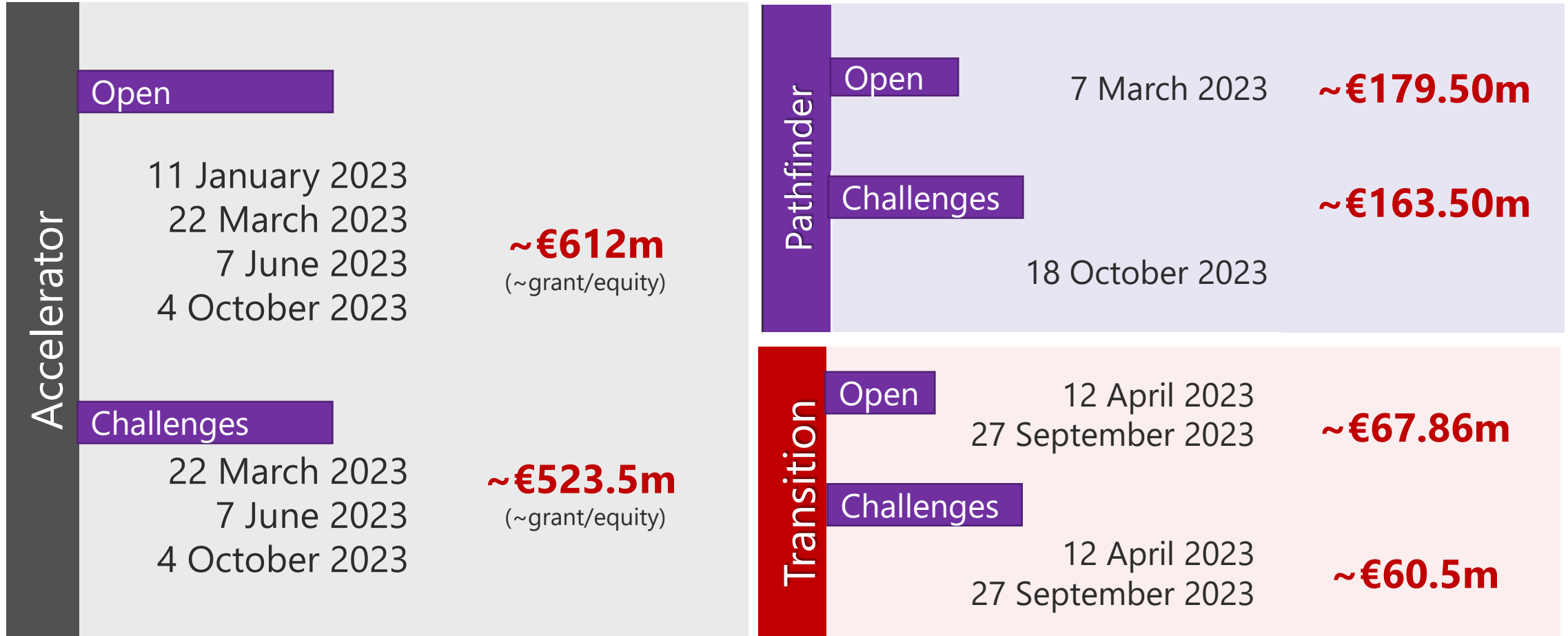
Overview



- **Budget: €1.66 billion**
 - Pathfinder: €343 million
 - Transition: €128 million
 - Accelerator: €1.13 billion
- **Strong continuity** for main calls
- **More frequent cut-offs (4) & improved resubmissions** for Accelerator
- **More targeted EIC challenges**, especially for Accelerator challenges
- A new **internship scheme** and new support to **customise innovations** for prospective clients
- A new **Executives in Residence** action
- **New ecosystem approach** for Business Acceleration Services
- A new **Humanitarian Innovation Prize**

EIC main calls in 2023 - overview



Improvements for EIC Accelerator



- **4 cut-offs**
- **Strengthened evaluations**
4th expert evaluator to decide if a full proposal at **resubmission** scores **8/9 GOs**
- **Clarification** of resubmission rules
- **Continuation of pilot** for larger investments (above €15 million) in strategic areas

A new approach to EIC Challenges



- **EIC Pathfinder:** more targeted challenges to avoid oversubscription
- **EIC Transition:** opening eligibility for all Horizon 2020/Europe results for Transition challenges
- **EIC Accelerator:** targeting of eight strategic areas for European deep-tech start ups (to open from March cut-off) with more specialist juries, etc.



Overview of EIC Challenges for 2023

€163 million for **five** Pathfinder Challenges

- Clean and efficient cooling
- Architecture, Engineering and Construction digitalisation for a novel triad of design, fabrication, and materials
- Precision nutrition

€60.5 million for **three** Transition Challenges

- Full scale Micro-Nano-Bio devices for medical and medical research applications
- Environmental intelligence

€523.5 million for **eight** Accelerator Challenges

- Novel biomarker-based assays to guide personalised cancer treatment

- Emerging semiconductor and
- Quantum technology components

Next generation innovation talents scheme

To allow eligible **researchers** (from Pathfinder, ERC, MSCA, RI, EIT) to carry out an innovation **internship in a hosting company** (EIC, EIT) for 3-6 months:

- **Deep tech research talents** (3-6 months) dedicated to highly specialised work on specific project, requested by the hosting company. This component is expected to attract the interest mostly of **ERC, EIC Pathfinder, MSCA fellows** along with EIT supported postdocs/doctoral candidates and EIT Alumni and EIT Jumpstarter beneficiaries;
- **Aspiring innovators** (up to 6 months) dedicated to more generic work in the host organisation. This component is expected to attract the interest mostly of **EIT students and graduates**.

Pilot support to test EIC innovations for potential clients / procurers

Consortium to be selected to organise calls for EIC beneficiaries to test innovations with public or private procurers

- **Grants of € 20-60K** for EIC beneficiaries to test innovations
- In-kind commitment of procurers for access to facilities, expertise, data etc and preparation of validation report

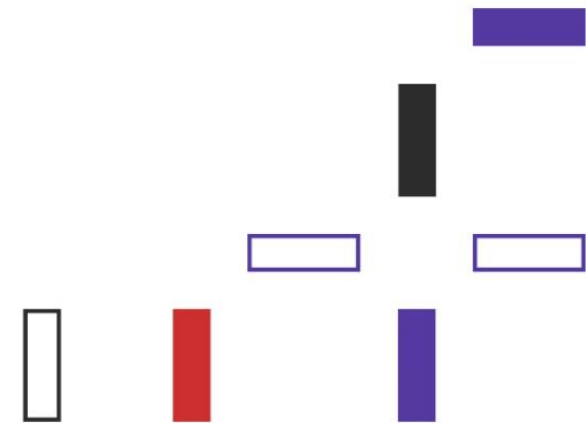




Pilot Executives in Residence action

- Identify a set of promising research results with spin-off potential from Pathfinder / Transition
- Set up of a network of C-level executives to mentor EIC research projects with spin-out potential
- Implemented by the EIB Institute Budget: up to € 2 million

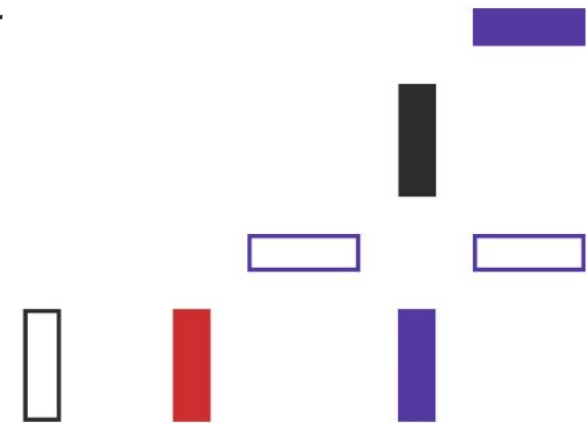




BAS Ecosystem partnerships

- Call for organisations to become **EIC Ecosystem Partners** to provide services for incubation, acceleration, growth and scale-up
- EIC beneficiaries to access EIC Ecosystem Partner services through service catalogue & matching
- Includes reinforced collaboration with EIT to access relevant services from **KICs**

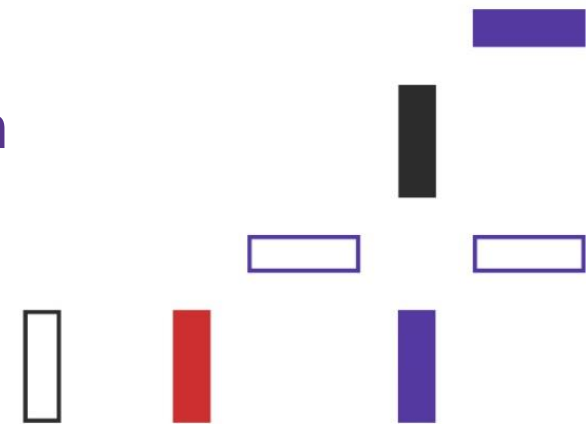
