

- The EIC STEP Scale Up call is currently using existing standard Horizon Europe forms for the application process. Given these forms terminology does not always align with an equity based terminology, this guidance document aims to clarify and facilitate the application process.
- This guidance refers to the Part A form on the EU Funding & Tenders Portal. In general please disregard any references in the form to grants as they are not relevant for the STEP equity only call.
- In addition, references to researchers and publications may be disregarded if they are not applicable to your proposal.
- Questions on ethics and security are standard for Horizon Europe and must be answered.
